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1. **Exam Name - CSIR-UGC NET JRF Exam in Life Science.**

Conducted by - National Testing Agency (NTA) conducts twice a year in June and December.

A) NET JRF (NET- **Junior Research Fellowship**): a part from lectureship you can do PhD in research institutes or universities with five year fellowship (JRF - Rs. 31,000/- for first 2 years and SRF Rs. 35,000/- for next 3 years)

B) NET LS only (**Lectureship/Assistant Professor**): minimum eligibility for lectureship / Assistant professor in colleges and universities across India. You are eligible for doing PhD in most of the universities and will be exempted from university entrance.

Age Limit: The upper age limit for applying for the award of JRF shall be **28 years**, which is relaxed upto **5 years** in the case of candidates belonging to SC/ST/OBC, Physically Handicapped/Visually Handicapped and female applicants.

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Mode of Exam: Online Multiple Choice Questions (MCQs) exam with Maximum 300 Marks and 3 Hrs Duration.

The question paper is divided in two sections;

Section A - This part shall carry 50 compulsory questions pertaining to General Science, Quantitative Reasoning & Analysis and Research Aptitude

Section B - This part shall contain 150 Multiple Choice Questions(MCQs) questions out of which only 50 questions you can attempt, questions generally covering the topics given in the syllabus and some scientific concepts and/or application of the scientific concepts.
