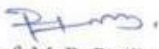

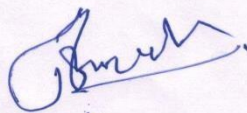
Report

The practice of keeping a clean environment has immense importance. A clean environment helps in the prevention of illness and spread of various diseases. To instill the importance of a clean and green environment among the students, a cleanliness campaign was organized by the N.S.S department of the college from 01-09-17 to 15-09-17. As a part of the cleanliness campaign, N.S.S volunteers have done cleanliness of the areas beyond the campus. Vegetable markets can be a source for the growth of pathogenic microorganisms. Foul odour is spread due to spoiled vegetables. So, these areas were chosen for the cleanliness drive. On 06-09-17, NSS volunteers went to the areas which included Saiful vegetable market, vegetable market near Bharti University and in D Mart. On 07-09-17, N. S. S. volunteers went to Shahu charitable hospital, Vijapur road, Solapur and did labour donation by cleaning the surrounding area. Volunteers also sensitized the people in the hospital about the importance of cleanliness and maintenance of a hygienic environment. From 08-09-17 to 09-09-17, volunteers visited Hattur village (Solapur district) and cleaned the surrounding areas like Bansiddheshwar slum, Someshwar nagar and Someshwar temple. About 10 different N.S.S volunteers along with N.S.S program officer participated in these activities. These activities created awareness regarding cleanliness and its benefits among students.

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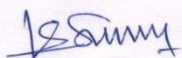

Report

As the saying goes 'Cleanliness is next to godliness', it is our prime duty to keep our environment clean and pure. Religious worshipping sites and pilgrimage sites where lakhs of devotees travel frequently, ought to be kept clean. One such sacred religious site of pilgrimage in the state of Maharashtra is Pandharpur city in Solapur district where devotees worship Lord Vitthal. Every year during Aashadhi ekadashi, about lakhs of pilgrims travel to Pandharpur for the blessings of Lord Vitthal. Plastic and thermocol plates are used by pilgrims for eating meals. As plastic as well as thermocol are non-biodegradable, they must be replaced by biodegradable material. For plastic and thermocol free pilgrimage, the distribution of eco-friendly paper (for use as plates for eating

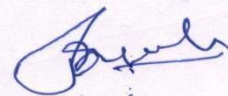
meals) and its collection after use needs to be done. For this purpose, on 25-07-18, 14 N.S.S volunteers of our college and 2 staff members (Mr. M.B. Kamble and Mr. D.D. Bansode) were sent in the places of Chandrabhaga river ghat and vaalvant parisar stone bridge to Uddhav Ghat in the city of Pandharpur.

Students distributed the eco-friendly paper to pilgrims and the used paper was collected and dumped in the dustbins. Students also spread the message regarding plastic and thermocol free pilgrimage among the pilgrims and citizens present at the site of pilgrimage. These activities helped to inculcate the importance of cleanliness and the use of biodegradable eco-friendly material among the students, staff members as well as pilgrims.

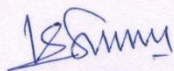

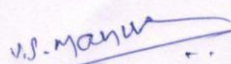

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Environment promotion activities 2019-20

Report

The year 2019 marks the completion of 5 years of the Swachh Bharat mission launched by our Prime minister Shri Narendra Modi on 2nd October 2014. The year 2019 also marks the 150th birth anniversary of the father of our nation, Mahatma Gandhi. Keeping these auspicious occasions in mind, a cleanliness fortnightly program was organized by the N.S.S department of the college from 1st August 2019 to 15th August 2019 (Independence day). During this fortnightly program, beyond the campus environment promotion activities were carried out by N.S.S volunteers. On 09-08-19 and 10-08-19, N. S. S. volunteers convinced the people of nearby areas like Vijapur road slum, Nehru Nagar, Saiful area about the importance of cleanliness. On 11-08-19 and 13-08-19, N.S.S volunteers went to Monarch Hospital, Jule Solapur and the bus stop area near the college and cleaned the premises. 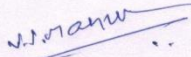

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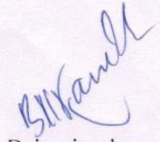
Clean environment promotion at Aherwadi, South Solapur, Maharashtra

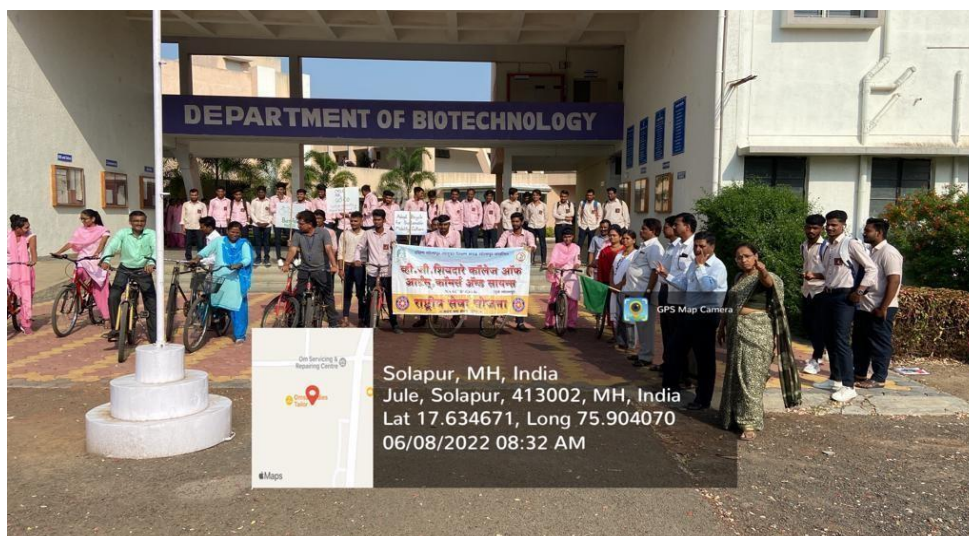

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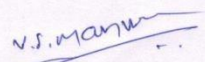
Cycle rally for promotion of pollution free environment
